HISTORY: Adopted by the Mayor and Borough Council of the Borough of Seaside Park 5-1-1986 as Ordinance No. 963.¹
 GENERAL REFERENCES: See Chapter 60 (Salaries and Wages).

Be it ordained by the Mayor and Borough Council of the Borough of Seaside Park, in the County of Ocean and State of New Jersey, as follows:

§11-1. Position established.¹

There is hereby established the position of Tax Assessor of the Borough of Seaside Park. Additionally, the governing body is empowered to appoint a Deputy Tax Assessor or Assessors as the need occurs.

§11-2. Appointment.

The Municipal Tax Assessor and any Deputy Assessor shall be appointed for a term of four (4) years by the Mayor with the advice and consent of the governing body, and said terms shall commence on July 1 following said appointment. Vacancies shall be filled by appointment for the unexpired term.

§11-3. Salary.

The salary of the Municipal Tax Assessor and any Deputy Assessor shall be as determined in the duly adopted salary ordinance of the Borough of Seaside Park.²

§11-4. Qualifications, duties and tenure.

The qualifications, duties and tenure rights shall be controlled by New Jersey State statute.

§11-5. Repealer.

This ordinance repeals any inconsistent ordinance or ordinances or part or parts thereof.

§11-6. When effective.

This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon final passage and publication as required by law.
