HISTORY: Adopted by the Mayor and Borough Council of the Borough of Seaside Park 4-1-1949 as Ordinance No. 490.

Be it ordained by the Mayor and Borough Council of the Borough of Seaside Park, in the County of Ocean and State of New Jersey, as follows:

§22-1. Court established.

A Municipal Court for the Borough of Seaside Park, in the County of Ocean, is hereby established pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 264 of the Laws of 1948,¹ as amended and supplemented.

§22-2. Court named.

The name of the Municipal Court shall be the "Municipal Court of Seaside Park."

§22-3. Court seal.

The Municipal Court shall have a seal which shall bear the impress of the name of the Court.

§22-4. Municipal Judge, appointment, tenure.

There shall be a Municipal Judge of the said Municipal Court, who shall be appointed by the Mayor with the advice and consent of Council, and who shall serve for a term of three (3) years from the date of his appointment and until his successor is appointed and qualified.

§22-5. Compensation.²

§22-6. Functions, powers, duties and jurisdiction.

The said Municipal Court and the Municipal Judge thereof shall have, possess and exercise all the functions, power, duties and jurisdiction conferred by the provisions of Chapter 264 of the Laws of 1948, as amended and supplemented, or by any other law.

§22-7. Court Clerk; appointment, salary, duties and tenure.

There shall be a Clerk of the Municipal Court, who shall be appointed by the Mayor with the advice and consent of Council, and who shall serve for a term of three (3) years from the date of his appointment and until his successor is appointed and qualified. The Clerk of the Municipal Court shall receive an annual salary,³ to be paid in the same manner as the salaries of other municipal officers are paid, and which shall be in lieu of all fees, costs and any other allowances whatsoever. He shall perform such functions and duties as shall be prescribed for him by law, the rules applicable to municipal courts, and by the Municipal Judge.

§22-8. Court session; location⁴ and duration.

The Municipal Court shall be held at the Council Chambers of the Municipal Building, situated at the northwest corner of West Central and 4th Avenues in Seaside Park, New Jersey. The Municipal Judge shall sit at such times as the business of the Court may require, subject to the rules applicable to municipal courts.

§22-9. Inconsistent ordinances repealed.

All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance are repealed.

§22-10. When effective.

This ordinance shall take effect when adopted and published as required by law.
