HISTORY: Adopted by the Mayor and Borough Council of the Borough of Seaside Park 5-25-1954 as Ordinance No. 549.

GENERAL REFERENCES: See Chapter 78 (Water and Sewers).

Be it ordained by the Mayor and Borough Council of the Borough of Seaside Park, in the County of Ocean and State of New Jersey, as follows:

§4-1. Recirculation equipment required.

No person, firm or corporation shall have installed and connected to the water system and/or the sewer system of the Borough of Seaside Park any type of water-cooled air-conditioning unit unless and until adequate arrangements are made to insure that the said air-conditioning unit shall be so installed that water used therein shall be recirculated by means of a tower or condensing unit.

§4-2. Inspection prior to installation.

No water-cooled air-conditioning unit shall be connected to the water and/or sewer system of the Borough of Seaside Park unless and until the recirculation system set forth in §4-1 is inspected and approved by the Borough Superintendent.¹

§4-3. Violations and penalties.

Any person or persons violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall, upon conviction before the Municipal Judge of the Borough of Seaside Park, pay a fine not exceeding fifty dollars (\$50.), or imprisonment in the county jail for a term not exceeding ten (10) days, or both fine and imprisonment, in the discretion of the Municipal Judge having jurisdiction.

§4-4. When effective.

This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its final passage, approval and publication as required by law.
