HISTORY: Adopted by the Mayor and Borough Council of the Borough of Seaside Park 2-7-1925 as Ordinance No. 311. Amended 12-20-2001 by Ord. No. 1291.

Be it ordained by the Mayor and Borough Council of the Borough of Seaside Park, in the County of Ocean and State of New Jersey, as follows:

§18-4. When effective.
This ordinance shall take effect when passed and published according to law.

§18-1. Conformity with map.
The numbers of all houses erected within the limits of the Borough of Seaside Park shall correspond with the street numbers on the map of the Borough of Seaside Park on file in the office of the Borough Clerk of said borough, and it shall be the duty of all property owners to have their houses numbered in conformity with the street numbers as the same are designated on said map.

§18-2. Obtaining and posting number.
In all cases where any number is or shall be hereafter affixed to any house, it shall be the duty of the owner thereof to apply to the Borough Clerk for the correct number of said house as the same is indicated on the map of said borough, and upon said application, the said Clerk shall furnish to the said applicant the correct number to designate his said property, and the said property owner shall thereupon place and affix to the said house a sign indicating the number of the said house on the street whereon it is situate, in conformity with the street number of said lot as furnished by the Borough Clerk, upon which the said house is located.

§18-3. Violations and penalties.

Any person who violates any one (1) or more sections of this ordinance shall be subject to a fine of not more than one thousand (\$1,000.) dollars for each separate offense and/or confinement in the Ocean County Jail for a period of not more than ninety (90) days.
