FEEES FOR VARIOUS SERVICES

ARTICLE I
Miscellaneous Fees

§30-1.1 Miscellaneous fees.

Be it ordained by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Seaside Park, in the County of Ocean and State of New Jersey, as follows:

- A. For the purchase of the following Borough records:
Tax Maps (12" x 18").....\$40.00
Tax Maps (24" x 36").....\$80.00
Borough Code (including Development Regulations Ordinance).....\$50.00
Borough Code Supplement (January 1 - December 31).....\$20.00
Development Regulations Ordinance.....\$20.00
Master Plan.....\$50.00
B. For photocopying documents and public records of the borough:
First to tenth page..... \$0.75 per page
Eleventh to twentieth page \$0.50 per page
All pages over twenty..... \$0.25 per page
C. For photocopies produced using borough equipment:
Letter size (8 1/2" x 11") \$0.25 per page
Legal size (8 1/2" x 14")..... \$0.25 per page
D. Returned check charge.....\$20.00
E. Bulkhead Applications. Where the borough is requested to endorse a bulkhead application to include engineering review and legal fees required for approval resolution, a fee of \$275.00.

ARTICLE II
Police Fees

§30-2.1 Police fees.

F. Recreation Activity Fees. The following recreation fees are hereby:

- 1. Arts & Craft Show (per space)..... \$100.00
2. Recreation Leagues (per team)
Minimum \$200.00
Maximum \$800.00
The governing body shall establish actual team charges from time to time by resolution of the Borough Council.
3. Miscellaneous Other Activities (per person):
Minimum \$5.00
Maximum \$100.00

G. Public Defender Application Fee. The Borough of Seaside Park hereby establishes a fee for those applying for a Municipal Public Defender in the Borough of Seaside Park Municipal Court. The fee shall be two hundred dollars (\$200.) but the Judge of the Municipal Court may waive any required application fee, in whole or in part, if the court determines, in its discretion, that the application fee represents an unreasonable burden on the person seeking representation.

H. For certified copies of birth, marriage, domestic partnership and death certificates a fee of \$5.00 per certificate.

ARTICLE II
Police Fees

§30-2.1 Police fees.

A. All requests for discovery in matters pending in the Seaside Park Municipal Court shall be submitted through the Municipal Prosecutor.

- B. The following fees shall be payable by the requesting party to the Borough of Seaside Park for the discovery provided:
- (1) \$.75 per page for each of the first 10 pages photocopied
 - (2) \$.50 per page for each of the next 10 pages photocopied
 - (3) \$.25 per page for each of the pages photocopied thereafter
 - (4) Actual postage for any discovery sent by mail
 - (5) \$.25 for the envelope for any discovery sent by mail
 - (6) Photographs will be photocopied at the rates established herein. If requests are made for duplicate photographs, the actual cost of making the photographs shall be charged.
 - (7) Duplication of videotapes constitute an extraordinary duplication process and will be charged at the rate of \$5.00 per videotape.
 - (8) On any item that cannot be photocopied on the Borough copy machine or not otherwise provided for in this schedule, the actual cost incurred in making the copy shall be charged.
- C. Where the discovery must be obtained from an entity other than the Borough of Seaside Park, e.g. another police department, the actual costs paid to the other entity shall be paid by the requestor.
