



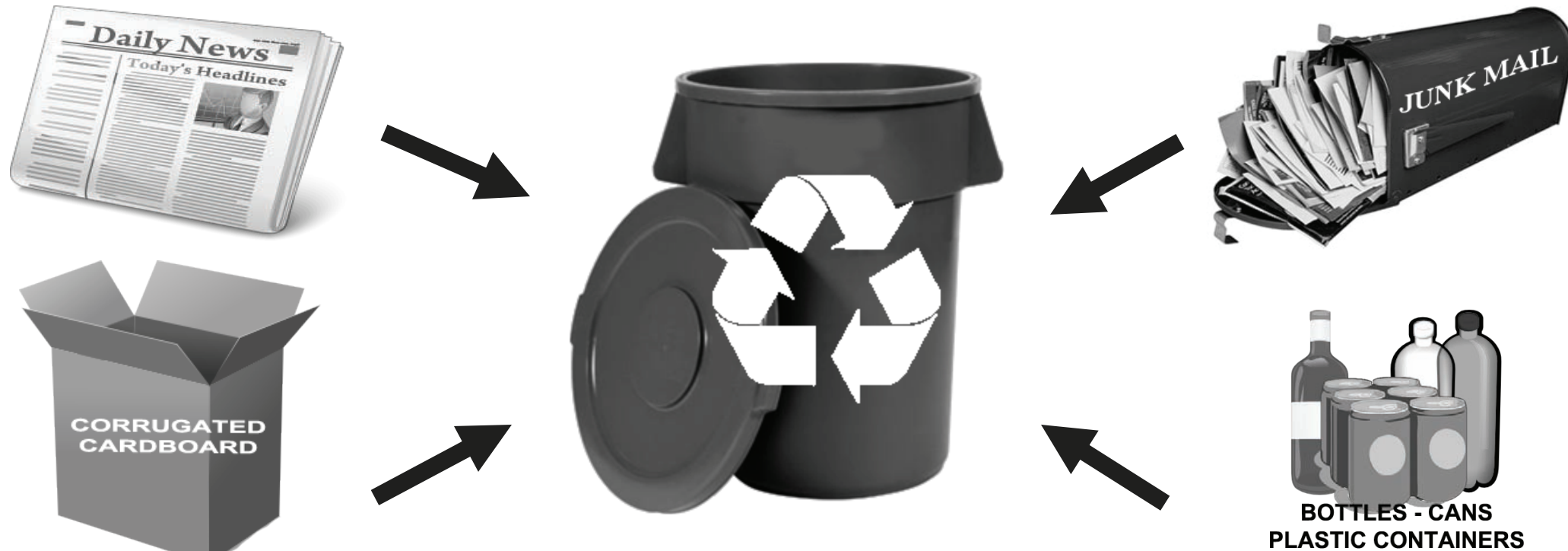
SEASIDE PARK—CURBSIDE—SINGLE STREAM RECYCLING PICKUP

STARTS WEDNESDAY—JUNE 2, 2010

Newspaper—Corrugated Cardboard—Junk Mail
Glass Bottles—Aluminum & Steel Cans—Plastic Containers

Starting Wednesday—June 2, 2010 you **may** place all of the acceptable curbside materials in one or more containers. If you choose you may still keep your recyclables separate but they will be picked up by the same truck. Recycling containers must not exceed 32 gallons or 50 lbs in weight and must have handles and a cover. They will NOT be picked up if they do not meet these specifications. Please see the Garbage & Recycling Calendar for the new pickup schedule. Please take note that recycling will be collected every Wednesday from June 2, 2010 to September 22, 2010. Saturday pickup has been eliminated at this time. Winter recycling pickup will take place on the 1st and 3rd Wednesday of each month from October to May.

PLEASE—DO NOT PLACE RECYCLABLES IN PLASTIC BAGS & DO NOT TIE ANY MATERIAL TOGETHER.

- Newspaper including inserts
- Junk mail, envelopes, catalogs, school & office paper
- Magazines, brown paper bags, shredded paper
- Corrugated cardboard (NO OIL STAINED PIZZA BOXES)

Starting June 2, 2010 you may place all of the acceptable materials in one or more containers. Recycling containers must not exceed 32 gallons or 50 lbs in weight and must have handles and a cover. They will NOT be picked up if they do not meet these specifications. Please see the Garbage & Recycling Calendar for the new pickup schedule.



- Glass bottles & jars
- Aluminum & steel cans including empty aerosol containers
- Plastic containers with a neck smaller than the body -please remove caps and lids.



DO NOT RECYCLE THESE ITEMS IN YOUR CURBSIDE COLLECTION OR AT THE RECYCLING DROP OFF CENTER

- NO gray chipboard boxes
- NO 6-pack boxes / cereal boxes
- NO shoeboxes / gift boxes
- NO refrigerated / frozen food boxes
- NO pizza boxes / paper plates
- NO wax covered boxes



- NO **PLASTIC BAGS!!!**
- NO Cups / mugs / ceramics / light bulbs
- NO Foil pans / aluminum foil / bakery plastic
- NO Peanut butter jars / yogurt / ice cream containers
- NO Tupperware / food storage containers
- NO Microwave containers / party platters
- NO Gable top containers
- NO Oil / Antifreeze / Pesticide containers

- NO Garden plastics / flower pots
- NO Styrofoam / packing material
- NO Window glass / vinyl siding
- NO Caps / lids / plastic wraps
- NO Toys / storage containers
- NO Milk crates / buckets / pails
- NO Coat hangars / mirrors
- NO Paint Cans (bring to DPW)
