Rabies Exp. date: _____ (proof required) **must be valid through October 31, 2026.**

Per State law, dogs must be licensed each year, after the first rabies shot and once they are over 7 months of age. The owner must present a current and valid rabies shot certificate with an expiration date after October 31, 2026. PLEASE NOTE: Dogs cannot be licensed if the rabies shot expires before November 1, 2026. The rabies shot must be updated and a new certificate presented first to obtain a dog license. First-time licenses can be issued any time after the first rabies shot, as long as it is valid through October 31, 2026. The dog license term is from January to December. New Jersey State law does not allow the waiver of any vaccination deadlines.

NJSA 4:19-15.4 Time for applying for a license.

The owner of any newly-acquired dog of licensing age or any dog which attains licensing age shall make an application for a license and registration tag for such dog within ten days after such acquisition or age attainment.
