 - e) Bottle-fillers - Ann Hayes will investigate the purchase and installation of these units. The purpose of which, is to reduce the amount of plastic bottles that are used and then disposed of. The cost is approximately \$600 for each.
 - f) Workshops - DPW director Eric Wojciechowski asked if the Committee would host 2 public education workshops.....rain gardens were suggested
 - g) Lynda Roberts asked if our committee should be involved in questioning the Off-Shore drilling. It was decided the subject was the Council's responsibility.
