The regular monthly meeting was called to order by Ann Hayes at 7:05, followed by the salute to the flag. Butterfly Garden - The maintenance of the area requires weeding, watering the barrels, sweeping the stones, etc. Lynda suggested that once the barrels decay the DPW should remove them. It was noted that the barrels belong to the Boro. it was decided that in the Fall they will be evaluated and either repaired or removed. Ann Hayes suggested the formation of a sub-committee to discuss mulching, planting, etc. Edie will inquire if someone on the BC would like to take the participate with the EC. This to be discussed at the Sept meeting.

Star Gazing - Edie printed the tickets and will also print some handouts. Ann Hayes will send her a file to include names, phone #'s and e-mails. Anne moyse volunteered to distribute flyers throughout SPP and report to Jane.

Subjects for discussion:


- 1) area living shoreline projects and relevance to SSP,
