

# Seaside Park Environmental Advisory Committee

## Wednesday.....February 13, 2019

The February meeting of the Seaside Park Advisory Committee was called to order by Co-Chair Ann Hayes with a salute to the flag. PRESENT: Ray Amabile,Cindy Kleva, Ann Hayes, Anne Moyse, Linda Roberts,Norma Spice..ABSENT: Lilian Amabile,Edie Klink,Jane Mason.

Ann introduced new members,Cindy Kleva and Norma Spice. She reviewed the function of the EC and the shared duties at the Butterfly garden with the beautification Committee.

OSPREY NEST....a definite decision will be made at the council meeting concerning the placement of the nest platform. Once this decision has been made the EC can proceed with plans for the dedication date, signs, and educational materials. The recommendation is the SW bay entrance to the Marina. Following the council meeting, Jane and Anne will meet with DPW for future plans.

MAGNET....As soon as council approves the nesting platform, we will move forward with plans for the osprey to be our "featured creature" this year. Anne will have an illustration and narrative for the magnet contest to review for the March meeting.

PUBLIC MEETING... In Lilian's absence, Ann reported that the meeting is scheduled for May 8th. The topic is "Reducing Single Use Plastic". members of the EC will volunteer for various jobs that evening.

April 13th is the date of the Spring Beach Sweep.

BUTTERFLY GARDEN.....Ann distributed a yearly schedule for the maintenance and planting of the area at 13th Ave. each member of the EC will take a turn watering and deadheading plants in the garden over the summer season.

Ann had information concerning a traveling "Butterfly Tent" exhibit. Various species of butterflies are housed in the tent. The EC would pay a flat fee for the exhibit to come to Seaside Park for all to enjoy free of charge. It was suggested that a July Farmers' Market at the Marina would be a great venue. The exhibitor also sells plants that are "butterfly friendly".
