The regular monthly meeting of the Seaside Park Environmental Committee was called to order by Ann Hayes at 7:04 PM.

### BUTTERFLY RELEASE EVENT...

Pat Moglia reported:

- 1) 3 butterflies were released into the wild....so many others were released earlier as they matured;
- 2) the much-reported rain held off until after the festivities;
- 3) a gift certificate was purchased and given to our vocalist with much appreciation;
- 4) at least 50 residents enjoyed participating in the festivities.
