Ms. Coleman reported she met with the Fire Company who completed their review of costs associated with the renewal of the interlocal agreement with Berkeley Township for fire protection.

Ms. Koury reported for the Operations Committee that she is continuing to work with the Public Works Supervisor to draft new ordinances to make signs more consistent with hours of operation for parking lots, piers, wharfs, recreation areas; also a memorial policy; license forms; event fee schedule. Ms. Koury noted the Planning Board will reorganize in February due to the January snowstorm meeting cancellation. The Board will hear the results of the Post Sandy Grant study. Ms. Contessa updated on the January snow removal by Public Works.

Mayor Matthies announced the upcoming FEMA informational session to be held in Toms River. He acknowledged the latest edition of the borough's newsletter is available on our website and at borough hall office. Mayor Matthies also acknowledged the latest Riverside Signal online edition.

Al Vassallo, 609 Central Avenue, inquired when our special counsel attorney Gagliardi will attend a meeting to update us on progress with the Central Regional School District. Mayor Matthies anticipated it will be sometime in March.
