Advance Traffic Impact Notice

**Date:** March 11, 2014

**Project:** Route 35 Restoration, Berkeley Township to Toms River Township (MP 0-4)

**Route/Direction/MP:** Route 35 / NB and SB / MP 0.0 to 4.0

**Municipality/County:** Seaside Park and Seaside Heights / Ocean County

**Nature of Work:** Stage 3B - Modified - The Contractor is required to install dewatering measures, excavate and install drainage facilities. If required, relocate existing sanitary, gas, and water mains. Reconstruct sanitary sewer connections, gas connections and water main connections for properties. Upon the completion of the utility relocations and connections, excavate remaining roadway pavement and construct curbing, driveways, sidewalks, ADA ramps with detectable warning surfaces, guiderail with non-vegetative surfaces, new pavement box (12" dense-graded aggregate, 8" HMA Base Course, 2" HMA Intermediate Course) and temporary striping.

**Anticipated Traffic Impacts:** Route 35 NB/SB detour to/from "J" Street and Central Avenue. The detour will be in place 24 hours per day for an anticipated duration of four (4) weeks. The detour route will be marked with "Detour" signs and arrows all mounted on Breakaway barricades pointing in the direction of the detour. Only side streets in conflict with our work zone will be closed at Route 35 NB. Residents located south of Lafayette Street will be able to access Route 35 NB/SB however they will be detoured at Route 35 NB and Lafayette to make a right on Lafayette. Residents located on the bay side will have access through "O Street. Home owner's driveways that are within the work zone will have ingress/egress to their property.

**Description of New Traffic Pattern:** Route 35 NB - The detour will direct Route 35 NB traffic to make a right turn onto "J" Street, then the first left turn onto Boulevard, in 14 blocks, a left turn onto Hamilton, then the first right turn onto Central Avenue (Route 35). Route 35 SB - The detour will direct Route 35 SB traffic to make a left turn onto Lincoln Avenue, then the first right turn onto Boulevard, in 12 blocks, a right turn onto "J" Street, then the first left turn onto Route 35 SB.

**Proposed Start Date of New Traffic Pattern:** Monday March 17, 2014
