



# SEASIDE PARK - GARBAGE & RECYCLING CONTAINER REGULATIONS

EFFECTIVE JUNE 1, 2010. The Borough of Seaside Park will NOT be collecting garbage placed in containers exceeding 45 gallons or 50 lbs in weight; or recycling placed in containers exceeding 32 gallons or 50 lbs in weight, pursuant to Chapter 38 - Ordinance 1492.

- Garbage containers are limited to a maximum of 45 gallons in volume, 50 lbs in weight when filled, & must have handles and a lid.
- Recycling containers are limited to a maximum of 32 gallons in volume, 50 lbs in weight when filled, & must have handles and a lid. Do not place recyclable in plastic bags for collection! They will be tagged and they will not be collected!
- Please mark your cans and lids with your street address so they may be returned to you during times of high wind.
- The Borough is not liable for broken or missing containers / lids.
- We strongly encourage the use of containers and discourage placing garbage at the curb in plastic bags. Seagulls and other animals tend to rip them open and make a mess. Cleanup of the mess will be the responsibility of the homeowner. If garbage bags are placed at the curb use black plastic bags—minimum of 2 mils. Again, no recyclables are to be placed in plastic bags for collection!
- We strongly discourage the use of ROLL-OUT/ ROBO CANS with attached lids as they are unsafe for our employees.

Any container exceeding the volume or weight limit will be tagged accordingly and WILL NOT BE PICKED UP - NO EXCEPTIONS.
