In response to the Borough's comments dated January 25th, 2022, enclosed please find the following for your distribution to Mayor, Council and the Planning Board. The Planning Board will be required to adopt the Municipal Public Access Plan as an Element to the Borough's Master Plan:

- One (1) copy of the Borough of Seaside Park Municipal Public Access Plan – Final Approval Dates need to be incorporated into the plan once its approved.

The following revisions have been made:

1. Page 7 of the Municipal Public Access Plan has been revised to state, "spouse or dependent children" instead of "families".
2. The 5<sup>th</sup> Avenue Pier hours on page 7 of the Municipal Public Access Plan have been revised to state "5:00 am to 12:00am".
3. The Public Boat Ramp hours on page 7 of the Municipal Public Access Plan have been revised to state "5:00 am to 12:00am".
4. Page 9 of the Municipal Public Access Plan has been revised to state, "As noted in Chapter 135-7, daily badges can be obtained at the beach headquarters and where designated by the Borough Council in subsection I".
5. Page 10 of the Municipal Public Access Plan has been revised to include "Trash / Recycling" and "Emergency Landing".
6. Page 10 of the Municipal Public Access Plan has been revised to include "Pickleball Courts".
7. Page 15 of the Municipal Public Access Plan has been revised to include "Decatur and 13<sup>th</sup> Avenue" and "Stockton Avenue" was removed.
8. Page 16 of the Municipal Public Access Plan has been revised to include "After September 15<sup>th</sup>, they are removed, and the entrances are allowed to naturally fill in to protect against winter storms".
9. Page 16 of the Municipal Public Access Plan has been revised to remove "Stockton Avenue".
